Children entering 10 years and under Novice to 4th Kyu can also enter in Children's Kata Novice - 4th Kyu under 16 years.

In individual Kata eliminations, the referee will select a kata from Heian 1-5, but will take in to consideration the competitor's grade – for example, 7th Kyus will only be given katas up to and including Heian Sandan. In the Ippon Kumite events, Aka (Red) will attack first, as follows:- one jodan oi-tsuke, one chudan oi-tsuke, one chudan mae geri and one chudan yoko geri (right side only). Shiro (White) will then attack. For the finals, the attacks will be with both right and left sides.

Entry Fees and conditions of entry

Individual Competitors: £10.00 per event. Team Kata: £21.00 per team. Spectators £10.00 (£5 under 16) - payable at the door.

Only currently licenced members of the KUGB will be allowed to compete. Instructors must ensure that licence details given on the entry forms are correct and should have sight of all competitors' licences when completing the entry form; this will avoid the need for a licence check on the day of the competition. Medical supports can only be worn with permission from the Championship Doctor. Gumshields and KUGB approved white hand-mitts are compulsory for Jiyu Kumite and groin guards are recommended. Chest protectors are recommended for female kumite events. Only registered members of your club may compete for your club. If insufficient entries are received in any category, then that category may be cancelled.
